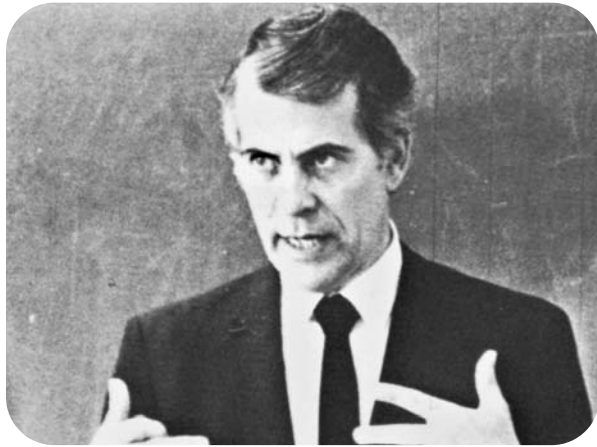


## A TRIBUTE TO BROTHER "CHUCK"
