

Fr. Jim Fitz , 63, professed first vows in 1965 and was ordained in 1974. He has served as assistant provincial of the Marianist Province of the United States in St. Louis since July 2002. Previous to this position, Fr. Jim served as director of campus ministry at UD and taught part time in the Religious Studies Department there. In previous ministries, Fr.
