## SUPERIORS APPOINTED IN TOGO AND ARGENTINA

During the General Council meetings in June, the consultations from Togo and Argentina were reviewed and two Regional superiors appointed.

Brother Maximin Magnan, SM, currently serving his first term as Regional Superior, has been appointed to a second term. Max first professed vows in 1986. He has served as a provincial councilor (former Province of Switzerland), sector coordinator for Togo, and Regional Superior. He also served as director of Collège Chaminade in Kara for more than 10 years. His second term will begin on September 12, 2010.

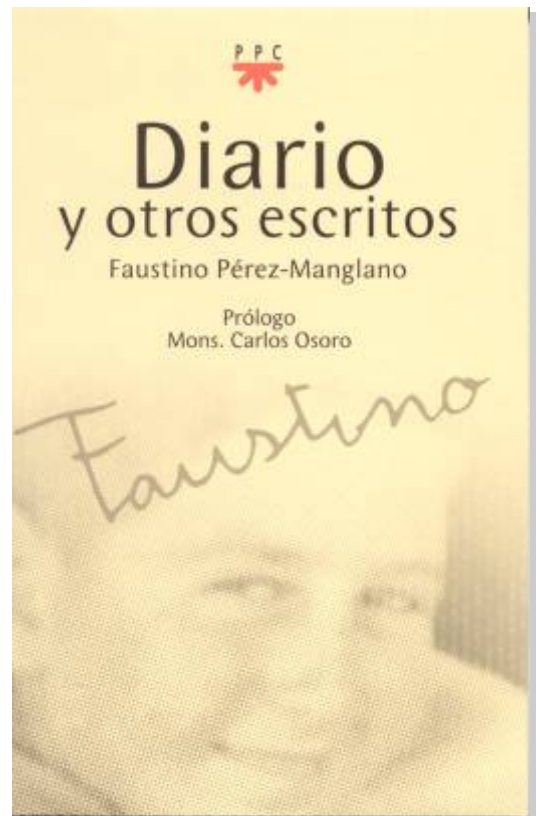
