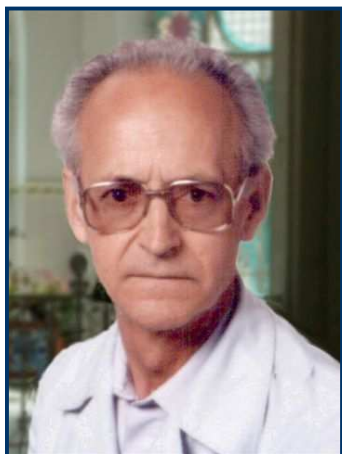

Death Notice No. 18 (To all Unit Administrations):



The Province of Spain, recommends to our fraternal prayers our dear brother, **MARCIAL DUEÑAS GONZÁLEZ**, of the Ntra. Sra. del Pilar/Siquem Community, Madrid, Spain, who died in the service of the Blessed Virgin Mary on September 4, 2012 in Madrid, Spain, at the age of 78 with 61 years of religious profession.

Our brother Marcial was born on June 27, 1934, in the town of Hontanar (Burgos). The son of Teodosio and Evilasia, at his father's death he became the ward of his uncle, Don José Dueñas, the pastor of Cordovilla Real (Palencia).

He entered the postulate in Segovia in October 1946 and then the novitiate in Elorrio (Vizcaya) in 1950.

After his first profession of vows in Vitoria in 1951, he went to the scholasticate in Carabanchel-Madrid, where he remained until 1955. During the fifties and sixties he alternated between working as a tailor and teaching in the primary grades in Segovia, Valladolid and Madrid.

1975 and 1976 were taken up by his studies, and in September 1977 he went to work in the printshop of the Ediciones SM, where he remained until 1985.

Then he took over the job as business manager in the Community of the Provincial Administration of Madrid, a service that he continued in the Community of Joaquín Turina, no. 37, Madrid.

In 2001 he retired, moving to the Community of the Colegio del Pilar in Madrid.

Twelve years ago, already ill, he went to the Residence of Siquem, where he remained until his death.

He was an Auxiliary Teacher of Primary Grades and earned the Certificate of Master Tailor in 1964, and that of Beekeeper in 1961.

A dutiful religious, austere, with a character all his own, he always held his Marianist identity in high esteem, offering many services to his brothers, students and friends.

May he rest in peace.
