Plans are underway to increase our efforts and, partnering with a local company, to begin creating job opportunities for these children.

None of this would be possible without your support and generosity. So many people benefit from your kindness: poor children in India; needy students in San Antonio, Cleveland, and Cincinnati; our aging brothers in our three healthcare centers; the Province efforts for peace, justice and the integrity of creation; and new efforts in Philadelphia and Los Angeles.

In return, we can offer what we have: our daily remembrance in prayer, especially at the Eucharist. May the Lord reward your generous heart as only He knows how.

THE MARIANISTS — NEARLY 200 YEARS OF MINISTRY

"I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least . . . of mine, you did for me." – Matthew 25:40

Guided in his vision by the Blessed Virgin Mary, Blessed William Joseph Chaminade founded the Society of Mary (Marianists) in 1817, following the upheaval of the French Revolution. The mission of the Marianists is to strengthen the faith, share Gospel values, educate the young and take a stand for the poor. Blessed Chaminade believed we are all missionaries in this effort. Today the Marianists are an international Catholic religious order of brothers and priests, with about 350 serving in the United States in education, parish and social ministry.

Education

Marianists seek to teach the whole person, developing students' intellectual, physical, psychological, moral, spiritual and social qualities. The Marianists sponsor 19 secondary/middle schools from coast to coast, plus Ireland and Puerto Rico, educating almost 13,000 students; and universities in Honolulu, Dayton and San Antonio that educate almost 15,000 students.

MUSP: Educate the less fortunate. The Marianist Urban Students Program serves

at-risk high school students, providing tuition assistance and mentoring to ensure they graduate from high school, attend college and find meaningful careers.

Partnering with the Poor

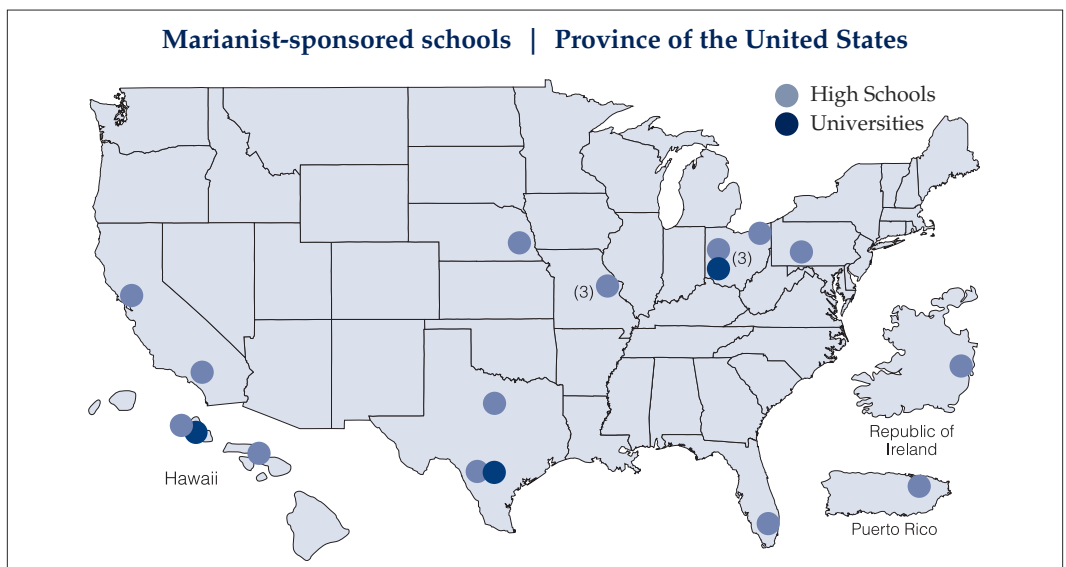
In India and Eastern Africa, Marianists are deeply committed to empowering poor women and children. They provide education, job training and micro-lending programs for women, as well as childcare, nutritional assistance, tutoring and education for preschool and school-age children.

Maintaining the Mission

Marianists provide assistance to those entering the order and those transitioning from full-time ministry:

Vocations. The Marianists provide a quality formation program for those young men seeking to become Marianist brothers and priests.

Care of our Elderly. Quality medical care and living assistance are provided for elderly brothers and priests who have devoted their lives to serving others.



PARTNERING WITH THE POOR

INDIA: EXTREME POVERTY

"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me." – Matthew 25:35

With 1.2 billion people, India is the second most populated country in the world.

Demands on society. Although India's economy is growing rapidly, it is estimated that there are 410 million people (a third of India's population, which is greater than the entire U.S. population) living on \$1.25 a day. There are vast differences between rich and poor, with little government assistance for the poor.



Women. Almost half of all women in India are illiterate. Education, job training and women's empowerment are essential to helping India navigate its social problems.

Children. India has the largest population of street children in the world. As the population of India increases, so will the number of homeless children.

Nearly 20 years ago, the Marianists began partnering with the poor in India. They started

Self-Help Groups Empower Women and Families

"I was recruited by the Marianists to run a women's self-help group, which pays me a small salary. I have borrowed money from the group to pay for repairs on my house, to

purchase a motor bike and to pay for my daughter's college fees. Four years ago, I took a loan to buy an auto rickshaw for my husband. From his income I am paying back the loans. For the first time we have a regular income. Over the years, I have recruited many women to be part of the self-help groups or start one of their own."

by serving the needs of women and children in some of the poorest regions of India.

There are more than 60 Marianists serving in the region and more than 50 young men at various stages of formation to become Marianists. They serve one parish and seven elementary, middle and high schools.

Ragpickers' Education & Development Scheme (REDS)

The Marianists also serve the poor through a program called REDS (Ragpickers' Education & Development Scheme). The REDS program serves families who live in the slums, barely surviving each day by picking through waste. The REDS program helps get them off the streets by providing meals and nutritional assistance and through educational, vocational and financial training.

AFRICA: EMPOWERING WOMEN & CHILDREN

"He upholds the cause of the oppressed and gives food to the hungry." – Psalm 146:7

In the early 1960s, Marianists were called by the Church to sponsor Catholic mission schools in Kenya, Malawi, Zambia, and other parts of Africa. Beginning in 1985, the Marianists expanded their focus by adding programs for the very poor. Through these ministries, the love of Jesus is taught, and students are fed, clothed, encouraged and surrounded by love.

Ministries in Kenya

In the city of Nairobi, the capital of Kenya, 85 percent of residents live in overcrowded slums on only 15 percent of the land.

Our Lady of Nazareth School (OLN):

A primary school in the slums of Nairobi that is home to 2,000 students

Ujamaa Family Center: Programming for parents of OLN students and others includes classes in family nutrition and hygiene, basic business and computer training and group counseling for abuse and domestic violence.

IMANI (Incentives from the Marianists to Assist the Needy to be Independent):

Chaminade Training Center is a technical school for unemployable young men and women.

The Job Creation Program and Marianist Development Project teaches business skills and provides job placement services.

Maria House serves poor unwed mothers and pregnant women through skills training to create a better future.

Ministries in Malawi

In Malawi, life expectancy is only 38 years, with average wages of less than \$1 per day. The country has more than one million AIDS orphans.

MIRACLE (Marianist Institute of Rural Artisans for Christian Life Education): A program for AIDS orphans that provides training in carpentry, construction, hotel services, tailoring, dressmaking, beautician skills and farming techniques as well as math, English, and Gospel values.

Chaminade Secondary School: A boarding school that has graduated more than 6,000 young men throughout Malawi since 1962. In 2010, 94 percent of the senior class passed the final exams; the national average is only 53 percent.

Maria House Enables Women to Start Their Own Businesses

"I came to Maria House and signed up for classes in hairdressing so I could run a beauty shop. In 2004, with a loan from the Marianists, I opened a salon in a slum in Nairobi that I call 'Miracle' because I am operating it with the hand of God. The Marianists taught me how to manage my finances and I now have three people working for me. Though the slum is a dangerous place, I am confident that my business will succeed."

MAINTAINING THE MISSION

SUPPORTING MEN IN FORMATION

"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." – Matthew 4:19

Blessed William Joseph Chaminade believed his mission was to bring people to Christ through personal relationships that fostered communities of faith. Over the years the Marianist order grew to hundreds of men and encouraged the growth of schools and social ministries.

As vocations grew, so did the network of Marianist high schools and universities. Social ministries to empower the poor were launched.

A change in population: Because fewer men enter religious orders today, the number of Marianists in formation has declined.

Currently there are about 350 Marianists serving in the Province of the United States.

As these men age, many are no longer involved in critical full-time ministries as pastors, teachers, chaplains, social

workers and missionaries and have less exposure to those seeking religious life.

To counteract this trend and connect with candidates so that vital ministries can continue, the Marianists use a variety of communications tools as well as "Come and See" retreats and other relationship building avenues. The Marianists continue to offer a quality formation program for young men who wish to be Marianist brothers and priests.

CARING FOR ELDERLY MARIANISTS

“And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.”

– *Philippians 4:19*

Although Marianist brothers and priests don’t retire, in their later years they do cut back from full-time ministry, finding creative ways to offer their gifts of ministry and prayer. This aging dynamic underscores two critical needs.

More Marianists need care: Nearly three-fourths of all Marianists in the United States are 70 or older.

Rising costs of healthcare: In 2011 the care of elderly brothers and priests was 30 percent of the Marianist budget. This amount is projected to increase to 40 percent by 2013. These are dollars that could fund the growth of ministries that educate and serve the poor.

The Marianists feel a loving obligation for the care of their aging brothers and priests. Their philosophy is providing dignity and care in a community setting

that is conducive to maintaining an active spiritual and communal life. It is important these men receive the appropriate care and resources that will keep them fully engaged in their ministries for as long as possible.

Marianist Father Stephen Tutas, 85, starts each day with a simple exercise: “I look back with gratitude for all that God has done in my life, I look forward with hope and anticipation,

knowing that God is full of surprises, and I try to live fully in the present moment,” he says. “But gratitude is what matters most.”

He has served the Marianists for 67 years as a teacher, administrator, formation director and superior general. He is actively engaged in ministry through spiritual direction, retreats and committee work.

There are many Marianists like Father Steve — those who taught in high schools, served as principals and school chaplains, worked as parish priests, social workers, missionaries and retreat directors — who are now in their later years and are still providing untold services including pastoral care, community leadership and personal assistance for the elderly.

EDUCATION

GIVING URBAN YOUTH A CHANCE

"Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it."

– Proverbs 22:6

Roughly 30 percent of all students who enter U.S. high schools today do not graduate, with about half of black and Latino students never receiving a diploma. There is a cost to both society and individuals for these dismal outcomes.

Cost to society. A high school dropout costs society an average of \$240,000 over his or her lifetime in terms of lower tax contributions, higher reliance on welfare and higher rates of criminal activity.

Cost to individuals. Behind the statistics are young people who never get a chance

in life, mostly due to poverty, lack of parental involvement and other factors.

To address the problem of high school dropout rates, the Marianists launched the Marianist Urban Students Program (MUSP) to assist students by offering them financial, academic and social support to succeed at a Marianist high school. MUSP operates in Cincinnati, Cleveland and San Antonio.

Scholars from MUSP are typically "at risk" students who receive mentoring and financial support from MUSP. The Marianists pay two-thirds of the annual tuition fee for each MUSP student. Students must get good grades, adhere to their school's conduct policies, participate in a set of enrichment and service activities, and have plans for college.

MUSP Teaches Students the Value of Persistence

Ricky Dennis grew up in a tough neighborhood in Cincinnati. He could easily have slipped through the cracks if it had not been for the mentoring offered by MUSP counselors. "I spent hours working on vocabulary words and different strategies for passing tests," recalls Dennis, a 1998 MUSP grad. His hard work paid off, earning him a college scholarship and dual degrees in graphic design and illustration. Now a successful graphic designer, Dennis believes his MUSP experience made all the difference. "I learned persistence. I know what it means to give it your best."

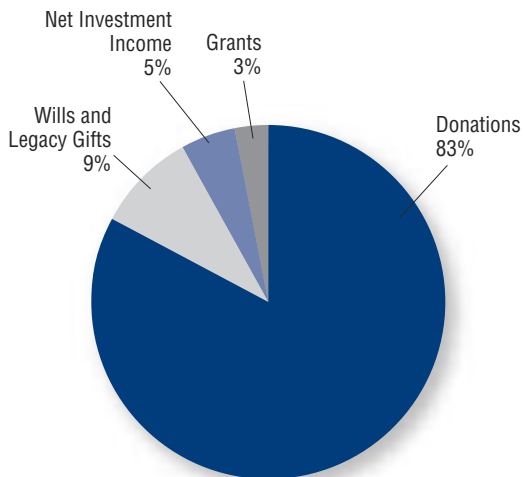

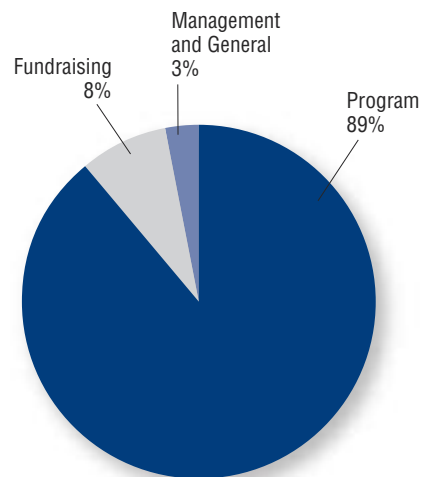
