Discernment process for Marianist leadership teams & boards

In October, the Office of Sponsorship hosted a Board Development Workshop. The CEOs of each Marianist-sponsored secondary school and retreat center were invited to participate, along with one leader from their governing board. **Jack Peterson** of <u>Managing for Mission</u> led participants through a series of presentations to help strengthen the governance and leadership practices of their Marianist-sponsored ministry.

Don Eggleston (Marianist Sponsorship Commission and former board chair of St. John Vianney High School) led a portion of the workshop and introduced a tool for discernment and decision making. The process is designed for leadership teams and boards of Marianist-sponsored institutions when faced with major decisions. The process is characteristically Marianist; it is mission focused and promotes clarity, reflection, consultation and dialogue.
