the students entrusted to her.



"Integrity of Creation" Included in Updated CMEs

The 25th anniversary edition of the Characteristics of Marianist Edition includes an update to one of the CMEs. The fourth characteristic now officially reads:

Educate for service, justice, peace and the integrity of creation

From the Endnotes of the updated document we learn: "The addition of 'integrity of creation' recognizes the contemporary understanding of the vital awareness and action toward what Pope Francis says in his encyclical, *Laudato Sí: On Care for Our Common Home,* regarding, 'dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet.'" Pope Francis explicitly states that *Laudato Sí* "is now added to the body of the Church's social teaching."



Sponsored ministries are encouraged to update their marketing and instructional materials as soon as practical to reflect this change.

Copies of the 25th anniversary edition of the CMEs were delivered to each sponsored ministry for distribution to administrators, faculty, staff and board members.
