Global Pact on Education

This past November, I represented the Marianist Province of the United States at a three-day Zoom seminar originating from Rome. The seminar explored a way of "reinventing education" by incorporating the Catholic social teachings promulgated by Pope Francis in *Laudato si* ´ and other papal encyclicals. This movement calls for a renewed vision of education as an instrument of social transformation.

It was an exciting experience, sharing with more than 600 seminar participants from around the world. After the seminar, I met online with Marianists representing provinces in South America, Africa and Europe to reflect on how the Global Pact on Education intertwines with Marianist educational tradition. **Bro. Maximin Magnan**, **SM** (Assistant for Education for the General Administration of the Society of Mary) has provided an excellent summary of our group discussions and the seminar topic titled **Global Pact on Education: An opportunity to renew the privileged means of our mission**.

This year's Marianist Administrators Conference (MAC) will be held October 22-24 in St. Louis and will feature a broad array of talented presenters and topics. - **Marianist School Principals Workshop**: Led by **Dr. Timothy Uhl** (an experienced Catholic educator and well-known national blogger and podcaster) and **Dr. Brett Desnoyer** (associate principal of instruction and mission at Chaminade College Preparatory School in St. Louis).

Saturday's schedule concludes with a group Mass, dinner and social time for participants.

Sunday, October 24 – is a travel day for board chairs. Ongoing programming for administrators includes a presentation by the presidents of the three Marianist-sponsored universities, time for peer networking and sharing, and a closing banquet and celebration. (Monday, October 25 is a travel day for administrators.)

Marianists Withdrawing from St. Anthony's Parish in Maui

The Marianist Province of the United States announced recently that it is withdrawing from <u>St.</u> <u>Anthony's Parish</u> on the Hawaiian island of Maui, effective July 1, 2021. The departure results from multiple factors, including a declining and aging population of Marianist priests and brothers. The Marianists had provided leadership of the parish since 1976.

The Diocese of Honolulu has allowed **Saint Anthony School** in Wailuku, Maui, to remain a Marianist-sponsored ministry, even when the Marianist priests and brothers are no longer physically present.



As part of the withdrawal, the Diocese of Honolulu will assume day-to-day operations of the parish and its spiritual community.

The Marianists will still maintain a significant presence in the Hawaiian Islands, including <u>Chaminade University of Honolulu</u> and <u>Saint Louis School</u>. The Marianists will also continue to provide ongoing support and resources to existing Lay Marianist groups in both Oahu and Maui.
