Ideal candidates will:

- Work in cooperation with the Theology Department and Administration to provide an experiential and voluntary dimension to religious formation and faith development.
- Provide opportunities for members of the school community to deepen their understanding of and commitment to Jesus and His message.
- Invite and encourage involvement in and celebration of the Church community through various forms and styles of worship.
- Help to foster the total personal and spiritual growth of each person.
- Help raise the school community's consciousness about contemporary moral and social problems and urge them toward a more just, safe, and peaceful world.
- Develop and coordinate all school liturgical/religious events.
- Develop and coordinate, in cooperation with the faculty, a full retreat program for each division in the middle school and the high school.
- Develop and coordinate Faculty Retreats and Faculty Days of Prayer.
- Work in conjunction with the administration and faculty to develop and implement an ongoing program for faculty faith development.
- Coordinate school community charitable activities.
- Moderating the liturgical choir.
- Develop and organize the school's Formation Program.
- Work with the Mothers' Club and the Fathers' Clubs on issues of their spiritual development.
- Function as a liaison with other area Campus Ministry programs.
- Work with the Theology Department to monitor and coordinate the Christian Service Hours Program.
