Collaborate with the President, Advancement team, and Trustees and participate in regularly held meetings to coordinate methods for engaging prospects and donors with other members of the team. Promote efforts to educate and inform STVM constituents of the opportunities for leadership annual giving, major gifts, planned giving, and endowment support of STVM through a variety of giving vehicles.

Travel regionally and nationally to individually meet current and prospective donors and to also represent STVM at a variety of events and functions throughout the course of the fiscal year.

Participate in professional development workshops, conferences, and seminars to remain current of Advancement best practices, particularly major gift and constituent relations strategies.

## Qualifications

Education - Bachelor's Degree or beyond

Experience - three or more years of professional experience in Advancement/fundraising or related experience in a profession that requires strong client acquisition abilities, relationship management skills and the ability to articulate a compelling case for support to all constituents.
