# **Pilgrimage to Italy: Home of Our Catholic Faith Hosted by Marianist Mission**

**With Pilgrim Director Fr. Tim Kenney, SM  
11 Days – April 13-23, 2024**

**Saturday, April 13 - DAY 1 – DEPART USA** – Today, we depart our home airport and meet at Newark airport for our overnight flight to Milan aboard a wide-bodied jet. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner, and breakfast aloft. (D,B)

**Sunday, April 14 - DAY 2 – MILAN**– This morning, upon arrival in Milan, we are greeted by our Unitours Tour Manager, who will be with us during our travels. We board our motor coach for a short drive to the Duomo di Milano, one of the largest cathedrals in Italy and a gem of gothic architecture with its magnificent stained-glass windows. We visit the crypt church and the tomb of St. Charles Borromeo, the first Archbishop of Milan and patron saint of seminarians. Mass will be celebrated before or after lunch on our own. Then we continue to our hotel for rest, our “welcome” dinner and overnight. (D)

**Monday, April 15 - Day 3 –MILAN/ VENICE** - This morning, we visit the Santa Marie delle Grazie, home of Leonardo di Vinci’s famous painting “The Last Supper” (subject to tickets availability, at the time of booking). We tour this magnificent church, as well as nearby Sforza Castle, a 15<sup>th</sup> century renaissance castle, which features numerous works of art, including Michelangelo’s last work before his death, the Rondanini Pieta. Following a break for lunch on our own, we admire

the picturesque Italian countryside, as we continue toward Venice, and nearby Mestre, for dinner and overnight at our hotel. Mass will be celebrated today. (B,D)

**Tuesday, April 16 - DAY 4 - VENICE -** Venice, the *Queen of the Cities!* The glories of Venice have attracted Byron, Goethe, Wagner, Shakespeare and now you! Following Mass in one of her beautiful churches, time is spent this morning walking the sights of Venice: the splendid Piazza San Marco and the incredibly rich Byzantine Basilica of San Marco. We marvel at the intricate network of elegant squares lined with stately Renaissance villas and palaces. This afternoon, we are free for shopping, personal adventure, or relaxation. We rejoin our Tour Manager and return to the Hotel in Mestre for Dinner and overnight. (B,D)

**Wednesday, April 17 - DAY 5 - VENICE/TUSCANY/MONTECATINI -** Today, we journey to Florence. On our scenic drive through this beautiful countryside, we stop in Padua to celebrate Mass and a tour of the Basilica of St. Anthony and view the largest bronze work of Donatello, “The Equestrian Statue of Gattamelata.”. Next, we continue to Tuscany and Florence’s delightful nearby spa town of Montecatini Terme, whose streets invite us to stroll after dinner at our hotel. (B,D)

**Thursday, April 18 - DAY 6 - FLORENCE** - This morning, we drive to Florence where our first stop will be “Piazzale Michelangelo,” for the best panoramic view of this spectacular city one could ask for. We proceed with a tour of the Academia Gallery, where we view one of Michelangelo’s most famous works, “David” (OR MEDICI). We continue with the celebration of Mass and a visit to the Duomo (also known as the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore), in the heart of the city and the fourth largest in the world! There we admire the cupola by Brunelleschi, completed in 1240, its campanile by Giotto. Once outside we view the Baptistery’s with its incomparable bronze doors by Ghiberti. We break for a leisurely lunch on our own at one of the many trattorias that dot the riverfront area, along Florence’s Arno River. The rest of the day is free for personal shopping or exploring this fascinating city on our own. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

**Friday, April 19 - DAY 7 - FLORENCE** – Today we visit the beautiful Basilica of Santa Croce. Among the most famous Italians interred here, lie Galileo, Rossini, Michelangelo, and Machiavelli. We continue our tour with the Piazza della Signoria, dominated by the Palazzo Vecchio and its embattlement crowned tower. Across from the Palace, we visit the Loggia dei Lanzi with the statues of the Perseus by Cellini; Giambologna’s the “Rape of the Sabines” and “Hercules.” Mass will be celebrated nearby. Following a break for lunch on our own, we enjoy some free time for shopping or personal adventure in any of the many art museums or to have a walk along the Arno River admiring the enchanting Ponte Vecchio, This evening, we enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants in this enchanting city. After our included dinner we return to our hotel for overnight. (B,D)

**Saturday, April 20 - DAY 8- MONTECATINI/ROME** - This morning, we travel south to Rome. This afternoon we begin in Rome with a visit to the Holy Stairs and Basilica of St. John Lateran. If time permits a driving tour of the Colosseum, Arch of Constantine and Roman Forum. We celebrate Mass, then proceed to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

**Sunday, April 21 - DAY 9 - ROME** – This morning, we go to Vatican City and enjoy the Sunday Angelus offered by Pope Francis if he is in residence. This afternoon, we tour the Basilica of St. Mary Major and the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. This huge, imposing Basilica, second only to St. Peter’s and one of the largest churches in the Christian world, contains an unusual gallery of papal portraits: 265 tablets portraying the popes of the past. We celebrate Mass below St. Peters. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

**Monday, April 22- DAY 10 - ROME** – This morning we see the treasures of the Vatican Museum. We marvel at Michelangelo’s restored frescoes in the Sistine Chapel and the wonders of St. Peter’s. Following our visit, we have lunch and celebrate Mass at the General Administration offices of the Marianists. The remainder of the day, we are free to further enjoy this fascinating city. This evening we have a Farewell Dinner with entertainment at a typical local restaurant. Return to the hotel for overnight. (B,L,D)

**Tuesday, April 23 - DAY 11 – ROME/USA** – Today, we make our way home with memories of a lifetime.

**TOTAL TOUR PRICE:** The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect July 5, 2023. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 30 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

**PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS:** A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Passport MUST be valid until October 23, 2024, or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** International flight reservations are being held on United Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure.

**DOMESTIC AIRFARE:** For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change. We encourage arriving a day in advance of departure.

**HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$812 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

**TIPS AND TAXES:** Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portorage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$114 plus current fuel surcharges of \$400 are included (subject to change). GRATUITIES OF \$126 ARE NOT INCLUDED AND WILL BE PRE-COLLECTED WITH THE FINAL INVOICES. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

**DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS:** A deposit of \$500 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received by Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made within 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date including insurance. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee (charged to deposit) plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee plus up to 50% of the land

cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

**BANK FEE:** A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

**DEVIATIONS:** A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Optional Travel Insurance is strongly recommended for your trip. See www.Unitours.com/TravelInsurance for full details. Cost of travel insurance for this trip starts at \$390. To cover preexisting conditions, insurance must be purchased with your reservation. (See reservation form). If paying by check, add insurance cost to your deposit. Insurance can also be purchased at the time of your final payment.

**LAND ARRANGEMENTS:** The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen emergencies.
