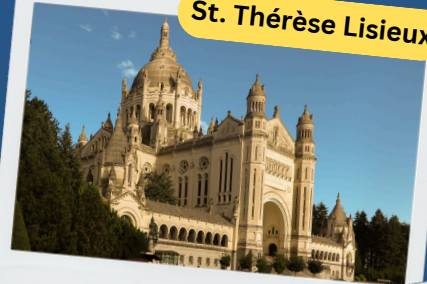

Day 1- 4: USA / Paris

- Opening welcome dinner
- Private sightseeing tour of France's magnificent capital with a local guide
- Prayer and reflection at Sainte Chapelle, renowned for breathtaking biblical stained glass
- Mass celebrated at the newly renovated Notre-Dame
- Free time to explore and relax
- Private motorcoach excursion to the magnificent Palace and Gardens of Versailles.

Day 4 - 11: Paris / Seine River Cruise

- Visit Les Andelys known for its imposing castle Chateau Gaillard, built by Richard the Lionheart in 1196.
- During your time in Le Havre, visit the seaside town of Honfleur, renowned for its picturesque harbor, and for being an inspirational site for Impressionist painters; Visit historic Le Havre and its UNESCO-listed streets.
- Experience the Normandy region with a variety of excursions. Choose the American sector or tour the British and Canadian sectors, each with its own powerful stories of heroism and sacrifice. You may also choose a full day excursion to the Pays d'Auge region; or journey back in time at the Seine Museum. Each excursion offers a unique opportunity to experience the history, culture, and beauty of Normandy.
- Travel on a private excursion to Lisieux, the beloved hometown of Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus. Celebrate Mass in her magnificent basilica, the second most visited pilgrimage destination in France, after Lourdes. Known around the world as "The Little Flower," St. Thérèse spent most of her 24 years in Lisieux, where her simple yet profound spirituality continues to inspire millions. Visit the historic city of Rouen for a self-guided visit to the Rouen Cathedral, once the tallest building in the world (1876–1880). Continue to the Old Marketplace, where a striking monument marks the site of the martyrdom of St. Joan of Arc, who was executed here at just 19 years of age.
- Enjoy scenic cruising around Vernon, where you will have 4 excursions to choose from, depending on your interests. Visit Claude Monet's home and gardens in Giverny. Wander around his gardens and homes where he lived for four decades. Or enjoy a guided tour of the 18th-century Chateau de Bizy, inspired by the opulence of Versailles.
- Travel to Auberge Ravoux in the heart of Auvers-sur-Oise, the last home of Vincent van Gogh; or enjoy the exquisite architecture of the Chateau de Malmaison, the former home of Napoleon and Josephine Bonaparte; or stay in Paris and explore the city on a guided bike tour. Drift along the Seine on a riverboat, taking in the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame, and Musée d'Orsay, as the city's bridges and monuments unfold in timeless harmony.
